Would you like to study at Frankfurt School, but your secondary school leaving certificate does not meet the requirements for direct entry into German universities? Or, have you participated in our assessment centre but weren't as successful as you had hoped? Consider enrolling in our Pre-University Foundation Programme.

The 20-week pre-university course will allow you to build your study and language skills, acquire additional subject knowledge, and prepare you for the rigor of undergraduate studies at Frankfurt School. In addition to taking classes in Mathematics, Economics, English, and German, you will learn more about local culture, and will become a part of Frankfurt School's vibrant international student community. You will also benefit from small class sizes, one-on-one academic counselling, and a safe and supportive learning environment.

After successful completion of the foundation course, you will be able to continue your academic journey in one of three Bachelor of Science Programmes : Business Administration, Computational Business Analytics, or Management, Philosophy & Economics.

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## Application Process

To apply to the FS Pre-University Foundation Programme, it is necessary that you first complete the regular Bachelor of Science application. This will allow our admissions team to assess whether you are eligible for direct entry into one of our Bachelor courses (BSc), or if you need to complete the foundation programme prior to starting your undergraduate studies.

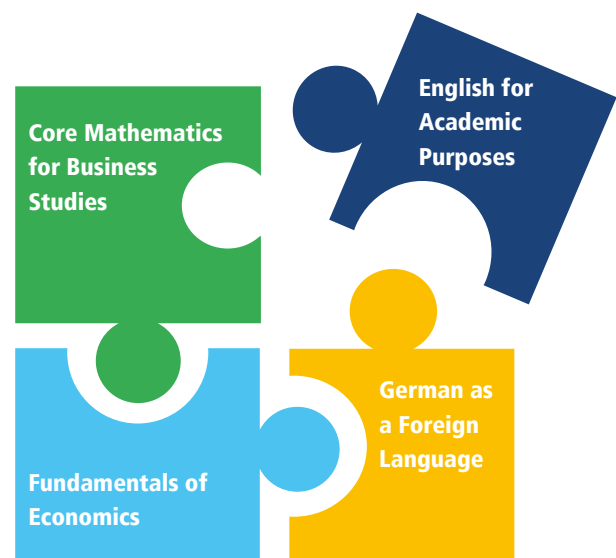
